Mr. Tom Anayabere - BEng, MEng, MIEPNG is a Electrical Engineer by profession and represents the PNG Council of Churches interest in the Security Industries Council. He is a registered Electrical Engineer and holds a Bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering and a Master's degree in Electrical Engineering (specializing in automated Systems) from Victoria University of Technology, Melbourne, Australia. He brings with him 26 years' experience in electrical engineering, with 7 of these years specifically in provision of UPS and surge protected power solutions and Contract and Project Management. This has seen him work for companies such as Telikom PNG Limited for 17 years, Dalco International Limited and Daltron Electronics for over 6 years as Operations Manager and Power Enterprise Solutions Manager respectively, and Meddent Ltd for 2 years. Tom's responsibilities spanned from Project supervision, Project Management, Sales, Marketing, After-Sales Support, Power Solutions Design, and Technical Service Support. He is a Registered Member of Institute of Engineers PNG (IEPNG), Registered Member of South Pacific Institute of Engineers (SPIE).

Tom was also the General Secretary of the PNG Council of Churches from 2004 – 2006 which required him to report to the Executive Council, in charge of all day to day operations of the Secretariat. This included planning, negotiations and allocation of community service projects between donors and implementing organizations, including AUSAID funded Churches Partnership Program (approximately PGK 15 Million annually spread through seven (7) major denominations). He also represented the Churches on several Committees, Boards and Councils including as Commissioner of Constitutional & Law Reform Commission, Member of Institute of Public Administration and Trustee Board Member on Tutuwe Trust – (a landowner trustee company with Ok Tedi mining).
